

Idsall Sixth Form – Parental Involvement Policy

It is the policy of the Sixth Form to involve all parents in all aspects of their children's education.

- For any Sixth Form event such as a Parents' Evening, KS5 Evening or the Higher Education Evening all parents will receive a letter of invitation with a reply slip. Parents who are not intending to attend can then be contacted.
- For each event an attendance list will be taken.
- In the case of a Parents' Evening, parents who were unable to attend will be contacted by letter and invited to contact the Head of Sixth Form concerning the progress of their child. If there is no reply they will be contacted by phone and invited to a meeting. If the child is under performing then the parents will be expected to attend a meeting. If they choose not to the matter will be referred to SLT.
- Parents will be involved in the review process and they will receive, by post, all reviews with an invitation to contact the Sixth Form if they have any queries.
- All relevant dates will be on the school website.
- Parents will be involved in the induction and enrolment processes via documents sent home via students.
- They will be expected to read the documents, sign them and return them.
- For any other event parents will be involved via letter and if need be further contact will be via phone calls or text system.
